School closed Friday 7th July 2023

As you may be aware, further strike action has been called for Wednesday 5th July and Friday 7th July 2023.

We have opened Colby School as usual on all other strike days to avoid disruption for children and their families. Unfortunately, as no agreement has been reached regarding a fully funded pay increase, many of us now feel compelled to take strike action and withdraw our labour.

On Wednesday 5th July 2023, Colby School will be open. Some classes may be supervised by support staff and we may be off timetable for some lessons. We have enough staff available to keep your children safe and happy but may not be following our usual curriculum on this day. **We will be unable to offer hot meals because of staff shortages.** Please contact Mrs Mead if your child is entitled to a free meal and you would like a packed lunch to be provided.

On **Friday 7th July 2023**, Colby School will be **closed** to all children. A significant number of staff will be taking strike action on this day and it is not possible for us to open the school safely. It is not a decision that we have taken lightly and we are sorry for the disruption caused.




Summer Reading Challenge
