Pupil Premium 2019 – 2020

The Pupil Premium (PP) was introduced in April 2011. This extra funding has been made available to schools to help narrow the attainment gap between children who are eligible for free school meals compared with their peers who are not. The Pupil Premium is allocated to children from low income families eligible for free school meals (FSM).

Since 2012/13 the FSM eligibility criteria was extended to pupils who have been eligible for FSM at any point in the previous six years (Ever 6 FSM). For 2019/20 the amount for Ever 6 FSM is £1320 per pupil.

In 2019/20 we have 6 children entitled to Ever 6 FSM and have been awarded funding of £7,920. We take the responsibility of spending all funds on our Ever 6 FSM children very seriously and detailed reports are shared with governors at every Finance Committee and annually at Full Governors' meetings.

Individual support:

Contribution towards school trips.

Free attendance at Breakfast Club.

Subsidised attendance at Breakfast Club.

Private tuition.

School uniform.

Individual support for teaching and learning (supported by a teacher). Individual support for teaching and learning (supported by a teaching assistant).

Group support:

Some Pupil Premium funding is used to provide services and support for groups of children, including some who have Ever 6 FSM.

In 2019/2020 this includes:

An early morning sport / leadership club to share high expectations and provide an energetic and positive start to the day. Led by two teaching assistants daily for 30 minutes.

Contribution towards the wage of teaching assistants to lead sporting activities at lunchtime.

Contribution towards a Higher Level Teaching Assistant's wage to provide after school tuition or additional one to one support in lessons.
