Emergency School Closure

Wintry weather is forecast so I thought it would be useful to remind you (and let Reception parents know) about procedures relating to Emergency School Closure. Closing the school will always be a last resort and I hope the arrangements detailed below will not be necessary.

Before the school day begins:

In the event of very severe weather I may have to close the school. If this is the case, I will inform County Hall as early in the morning as possible.

Information is available from County Hall in the following ways:

Local Radio Station

The closure advice is usually relayed after the news and travel bulletins up until about 9.30am.

Norfolk Website

Details of school closure can also be found on the Norfolk public website, <u>www.norfolk.gov.uk</u> by selecting 'Emergency School Closures'.

I will also post on our Colby Facebook page and Colby School Messages WhatsApp group.

During the school day:

If weather deteriorates during the school day it may be necessary to close the school or to cancel After School Clubs to ensure children / families and staff can get home safely. If I decide we need to close the school you will receive an email asking you to collect your child(ren). Details of closure will also be available by the methods listed above.

If it is snowing in the morning you may decide it would be safer to keep your child(ren) at home, depending on the distance you travel and considering your safety collecting your child(ren) if the weather deteriorates during the day.

We hope to have normal school days for the rest of this term, particularly as we have lots of lovely things planned, and will only close if we feel it is absolutely necessary because of safety.

Using Images of Children Consent Form.

Taking photographs is part of everyday life in Amber Class – it's a lovely way for staff to be able to share learning on the Tapestry website and for parents to see the fun children have throughout the day.

We also take photographs of children throughout the school for displays, for our website, newsletter and for applications for awards and competitions.

To comply with the Data Protection Act 1998, we need your permission to photograph or make recordings of your child. We have reissued our Consent Form to some of you this week to update our records.

Conditions of Use.

We will not use the personal details or full names of any child with a photographic image in any of our publications or displays (with the exception of the private platforms of Tapestry and Google Classroom).

If a child or group has won an award and we would like the name of the child to accompany a photograph separate permission will be sought before publishing.

We will only use images of pupils who are suitably dressed.

It is good practice to seek permission from the child before publishing a photograph.

Historic photographs may remain on our school website or Facebook page.

The majority of stored photographs of children will be deleted one year after a child leaves Colby School. However, there are some exceptions to this ie. Buddy photographs which are kept until one year after the younger Buddy leaves Colby School or photographs which may be used for promotion or competition / award entries. Please speak to Mrs Mead if you would like further details about this.

Photography is never permitted in areas where children are changing in or out of sport clothes or costumes.

Parent / family Use of Images.

When parents / families attend events and performances within school, they may take photographs of their children for their own private use when permission has been given by the Headteacher and the Governing Board – this includes events such as Harvest Festival, Christmas performances, Sport Days or sporting events. Photographs should only be used within the family and should not be posted on social media or websites. Posting images of children other than your own without permission is a breach of the Data Protection Act 1998.

If you had already given permission for all areas on the Using Images of Children Consent Form, you will not have been reissued a form this week. If you do not think you have completed this form, and haven't received one this week, please let us know and we will send you one.
