She has taught a few lessons in the Kobarid school talking to them about Colby School and the school system and sports in England (both are quite different in Slovenia).

#### **Year 6 Easter Homework**

Our lovely Year 6 children have worked hard this term and all deserve a good rest and time to have some fun. With the National Tests shortly after the Easter break, Year 6 children want to maintain their mathematical awesomeness or push on to the next level. Mr Mead has put together a pack of work for those that choose to do some work but it is NOT compulsory. The pack of work has been sent home with children.

Although the worksheets have numbers on them, children can do them in any order. If they do feel like something is too tricky, they can always move on to the next worksheet and we'll catch up together once they are back in school. There are also two lists of maths words to remind children of topics from earlier in KS2. I will have some treats and rewards for those children that impress me with their efforts.

We've told children not to get stressed out by the thought of holiday revision. There is plenty of time to do it, and a little and often is the best approach. Ten to fifteen minutes every few days is plenty. The most important thing, though, is to relax and come back to school refreshed so children should make sure that you don't over do it.

On the other hand, there's lots of other stuff they can do: they can investigate the Murder Mystery; complete recommended tasks to their diagnostic score on ixl; try the Countdown Numbers game on Happysoft; play 'Shut the Box' online or play Defenders of Mathematica on the BBC Bitesize website.
