Monday afternoon was rather eventful at Colby School! At around 1.30pm, a contractor who had been in school to quote for a painting job returned to his van to watch a tree get blown down from the field opposite Colby School, pulling down electrical cables and blocking the road. The bough of the tree landed on his van and lodged on the roof rack, stopping the trunk from falling further - this stopped the electrical cables being pulled to the ground.

We evacuated children and staff from Amethyst immediately because the tree and cables were very close to the mobile. They were taught in the main school building for the rest of the day. We blocked the area off with cones and made emergency telephone calls. We had very quick responses, with the Fire Brigade arriving within 15 minutes. They blocked off Bridge Road fully and remained on site to supervise the scene. Police and UK Power Network also arrived quickly to assist.

At approximately 2pm, our electricity went off. We were able to contact parents on the Colby Facebook page and the FOCS WhatsApp groups. We asked that parents collected children early, if possible, so that we could have a staggered pick up and keep Bridge Road as clear as possible. The Fire Brigade described it as a "protracted incident" and did not expect the road to be cleared or power restored for several hours. They warned us that it was not safe for cars to be removed from the staff car park! Thankfully, they were able to supervise staff vacating the car park at about 4pm and an impromptu Crazy Sleepover was not required!

A local tree surgeon, Liam Feeney (past pupil) arrived to help and the tree was cleared much quicker than we expected. We can thoroughly recommend his services!
