On Monday and Tuesday morning KS2 will have a Sports Championship. This is a chance for all children to take part in running, jumping and throwing events with their friends. Scores will be collated and added to their houses with every point being crucial to our end of year House and Sports Cup trophies! KS1 has the same event on Monday afternoon. These events are for children only.

Parents are welcome to come to school on Tuesday and Wednesday afternoon to watch children in our Sports Festivals. A chance to see our amazing children participate in sports events from our curriculum.

On Thursday we hold our annual Cycle Day. This is a fun occasion which allows all children in the school to take part in a series of activities throughout the day.

Families will need to drop bikes off either Thursday morning or the day before if you are struggling with logistics. All children will need a cycling helmet to take part. Each class will have specific events planned by myself and Ben to take part in throughout the day. There are always some children who are not able to ride a bike yet and they will have a chance to learn to ride with the help of school adults and Sport Leaders. If anyone is particularly worried then we will also have some scooters available for sessions on the playground and the path. It's a unique and exciting day and hopefully the children will really enjoy riding their bike round the field or even managing to cycle for the first time.

On Friday we will work as a school to see if we can run the collective distance of 500km (the width of Britain) as a whole school team. Children will be running with friends or individually from 9am to 3pm without stopping. Barnaby (Sport Captain) is leading everyone off with a 5k run before he passes the Baton to Reuben and Amber from Ruby Class. Small groups of children from each class will then be given a short distance to run before we finish at 3pm!

It's going to be a busy week, filled with fun and exciting opportunities. Please make sure children are in PE kit every day of the week with sun hats and plenty of water!
