Emergency School Closure

Wintry weather has arrived so I thought it would be useful to remind you (and let Reception parents know) about procedures relating to Emergency School Closure. Closing the school will always be a last resort and I hope the arrangements detailed below will not be necessary.

Before the school day begins:

In the event of very severe weather I may have to close the school. If this is the case, I will inform County Hall as early in the morning as possible.

Information is available from County Hall in the following ways:

• Local Radio Station

The closure advice is usually relayed after the news and travel bulletins up until about 9.30am.

Details of school closure can also be found on the Norfolk public website, www.norfolk.gov.uk by selecting 'Emergency School Closures'.

I will also notify the administrator for the Colby parent WhatsApp groups and post on our Colby Facebook page.

During the school day:

If weather deteriorates during the school day it may be necessary to close the school or to cancel After School Clubs to ensure children / families and staff can get home safely. If I decide we need to close the school you will receive a text message asking you to collect your child(ren). Details of closure will also be available by the methods listed above.

If it is snowing in the morning you may decide it would be safer to keep your child(ren) at home, depending on the distance you travel and considering your safety collecting your child(ren) if the weather deteriorates during the day.

We hope to have normal school days for the rest of this term, particularly as we have lots of lovely things planned, and will only close if we feel it is absolutely necessary because of safety.

BACK BY POPULAR DEMAND Christmas Party Food Lunch – Tuesday 19th December 2023

Those of you who have been Colby School families since before Covid will remember our epic Christmas Party Food Lunch. It's been a few years since our last one but children remember it fondly and have asked us to do it again. So, it's back by popular demand on Tuesday 19th December 2023 and we hope you will all want to take part.

Children in Amber and Sapphire Class (and children in Key Stage 2 who are entitled to free school meals) will be provided with a lunch of pizza and salad on Tuesday 19th December 2023 – their entitlement to a free meal. However, we hope you will help us have a wonderful Christmas Party Lunch by sending in some additional food so we can have a party buffet together in the school hall.

Key Stage 2 children are invited to send in food for the Christmas Party Food Lunch too. Colby Kitchen will not be providing hot meals for Key Stage 2 on this day (other than those children who are entitled to free school meals).

The chart below lists the food item that we would like you to provide for the Christmas Party Food buffet. It looks more complicated than it is – simply find your child's year group and the letter that starts their surname to find out what food they should bring in. For example: Harry Potter in **Year** 6 would bring **crisps**.

Please cater for around 8 children – you don't need to provide a whole feast. If you could send the food in a disposable container, that would be very helpful. Otherwise, please label any box clearly so we can return it to you afterwards.

If your child has food allergies, you may prefer to send them with a plate of their own party food. Please contact me if you would like to discuss how we can help your child enjoy the buffet safely.

Please send your party food donation in on morning of Tuesday 19th December 2023.

Any wrapped donations (crisps, wrapped biscuits, wrapped cakes) which are left over (if anything is) will be donated to a Christmas Food Bank.

If you would prefer your Amber or Sapphire Class child just to have their pizza lunch that day, please let me know. There is no pressure for children to be involved but we may need to reallocate food donations if children opt out. Key Stage 2 children can choose to bring a packed lunch instead but, again, it would be helpful if you could let me know in advance so I can ensure we have enough food to go around.

School Morning Drop Off

Please could I politely request that children are in school before 8.50am when the school bell goes and the gate is locked. The gate to the playground is opened at 8.30am to allow plenty of time for drop off. The gate is locked at 8.50am to allow staff to get the children in and settled before lessons start. It is disruptive to the whole class if children are late. The 8.50am – 9.10am timetable slot is often used for targeted intervention work or to talk about the lessons for the day ahead. It is unsettling for children to miss this time. With wintery weather ahead, please consider if you need to set off earlier to ensure children are here by 8.50am. Thank you for your help with this.
